



Business and Human Rights E-learning for NHRIs

Business and Human Rights E-learning for National Human Rights Institutions

Welcome to the first e-learning course on business and human rights for national human rights institutions!

Course Objectives

The objectives of this e-learning are to introduce learners to the field of business and human rights, and to consider how national human rights institutions can apply their Paris Principles mandate to business and human rights.

Target Group

This e-learning is designed for personnel within national human rights institutions. However, much of the learning material will also be relevant for civil society organisations, government agencies, and other stakeholders wanting to familiarise themselves with the role of national human rights institutions in business and human rights. We welcome all eager business and human rights learners!

Course Overview

The course includes an introduction, five core modules and a conclusion. Each of the core modules takes around one hour to complete:

1. Introduction to business and human rights
2. National human rights institutions and business and human rights
3. UN Guiding Principles pillar one - the State duty to protect
4. UN Guiding Principles pillar two - the corporate responsibility to respect
5. UN Guiding Principles pillar three - access to remedy

Languages

This e-learning is in English. The e-learning is also available in Spanish.

Independent and Facilitated Learning

This e-learning is designed as an 'independent' learning course which you can take without a teacher or supervision. It is also possible to take the e-learning as part of a 'blended' learning programme, which comprises a facilitated version of this e-learning, as well as a 3-day face-to-face training on business and human rights for national human rights institutions. 

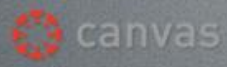
